

Handicap & Competition Rules for 2019

The following rules are to be applied for all team based competitions in 2019:

Scramble

- If Summer rules apply, drive being used plays the ball as it lies and all others place within 6 inches (no nearer the hole). Winter Rules: everybody places within 6 inches.
- Ball being used must play first.
- 4 Person Scramble: 1/8 of the combined handicap and 3 drives per player
- 3 Person Scramble: 1/6 of the combined handicap and 4 drives per player
- 2 Person Scramble: 1/4 of the combined handicap and 6 drives per player

Shambles (Champagne Scramble)

- Each player drives off. Best drive is chosen and every player plays from that spot, finishing out the hole with their own ball. Same Winter or Summer rules apply as per Scramble rules above.
- Full handicaps apply.
- 3 drives minimum per person in 3 person shambles and 2 in 4 person.
- 2 scores to count on each hole, using the stableford scoring system
- Every player hits their own ball on the par 3s

Rumble

- Play your own ball with the 2 best stableford scores to count on each hole in both 3 and 4 person rumbles

Scotch Foursomes

- On every hole, both players tee off, pick the best drive and play alternate shot thereafter until the hole is finished.
- 0.45 of the combined handicap applies
- Stableford scoring applies

Canadian Greensomes

- 2 person teams. Each person plays own ball for first 2 shots. Best ball is then chosen and hole is played out in alternate shot.
- Handicap is combined total of 0.6 of the lower handicapped player and 0.4 of the higher handicapped player. Stableford scoring system then applies.

Fourball

- Stableford scoring and 0.9 of the handicap applies.
