## RULES

- Each Club may enter only ONE team. Each team consists of 5 pairs and all matches must be played to a finish unless an overall result has been reached.
- **Caddies are not permitted at any stage of the competition.**
- In order to be eligible to compete in the Tudenhams Cup a player shall have, in the calendar year prior to the event, made a minimum of four returns in qualifying competitions (supplementary scores are not included), all of which must be recorded on the handicap records of the player's home club on or before 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018.
- Note: If a player changes his club during the previous calendar year, it is his responsibility to produce evidence of having competed in a minimum of four Qualifying Competitions.
- The minimum age for any competitor is 18 on **1<sup>st</sup> January 2019**.
- Lower combined handicap of **12** per pair will apply.
- Upper combined handicap of **20** per pair will apply.
- Maximum individual handicap of **18** will apply.
- The effective handicap date is **1<sup>st</sup> January 2019**.
- The player with the lowest handicap goes to scratch – 9/10 of the difference of full handicap rule applies to the remaining players in the fourball.
- Matches will be played on a 3:2 home & away split as in the Barton Cup competition.
- Team on the top of draw will have home advantage i.e. 3 matches at home.
- Both Clubs to arrange and organise the matches.
- The respective Team Captains about to engage in a match shall exchange simultaneously, the names and handicaps of the members of their team in correct order of play with the names and handicaps of reserves not less than 30 minutes before the start of the match.
- Except in the case of sudden illness or other emergency which is considered by both Team Managers to be sufficient justification, no alteration can be made to the list handed in, either in the matter of players or in the order of play. Reserves taking the place of players after the team has been submitted, shall be placed in the same position in the team as that occupied by the player who has taken ill or has been withdrawn.
- No extensions of date will be granted. If clubs cannot agree on a date for playing a match, the match must be played on the final date for that round or be eliminated.
- No player may represent more than one Club in any one year. Penalty is disqualification of player concerned.
- The use of Buggies is prohibited unless accompanied by an up-to-date medical certificate. However, the Home Club's rule on this must be observed.
- The winning club in each round must notify the result not later than two days after conclusion of the match to the office Mullingar Golf Club - Tel: (044) 9348366 or email: [info@mullingargolfclub.ie](mailto:info@mullingargolfclub.ie)
- The Trophy shall be held by the winning Club and such Club shall be responsible for the safe custody and return to Mullingar Golf Club before the final the following year.
- The decision of Mullingar Golf Club shall be final on any question arising out of this tournament.
- Final will take place in Mullingar Golf Club on **Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> August**.
